

“C” Category

1. Participates in at least 1 of these competitions: Canada Games, Western Canada Summer Games, Arctic Winter Games, North American Indigenous Games, National or International or Western Canadian or Provincial Championship.
2. Provides skill and leadership development programs in 2 or 3 levels for athletes, coaches, officials, and administrators.
3. C1 (\$7,500) Number of communities: 10 – 12
C2 (\$6,000) Number of communities: 8 - 9
4. Number of registered members: Team Sport: 501 - 1000
Individual Sport: 101 - 300

“D” Category

1. Provides skill and leadership development programs in 1 or 2 levels for athletes, coaches, officials, and administrators.
2. D1 (\$4,500) Number of communities: 4 – 7
D2 (\$3,500) Number of communities: 2 - 3
3. Number of registered members: Team Sport: 20 - 500
Individual Sport: 20 - 100

“E” Category (\$1,500)

Existing members who do not meet all of the recognition criteria, but meet the following:

- good standing with Registrar of Societies of the Northwest Territories;
- completed the Federation's Funding Allocation application and accountability for the current year;
- representation at the Sport North Annual General Meeting and any Special General Meetings of Sport North; and
- is a Territorial Association.

1.2 Performance Funding

This funding component is intended to reward active members based on their activities, or “performance.” This category follows a point allocation method whereby points are awarded for certain types of activities. In addition to meeting the criteria as an *Active Member*, TSOs must also meet the criteria for one of the categories from “A” through “D” under the *Base Funding* component. The activities that qualify for *Performance Funding*, the point values assigned, and the maximum number of events eligible to receive points are shown on the table below.
